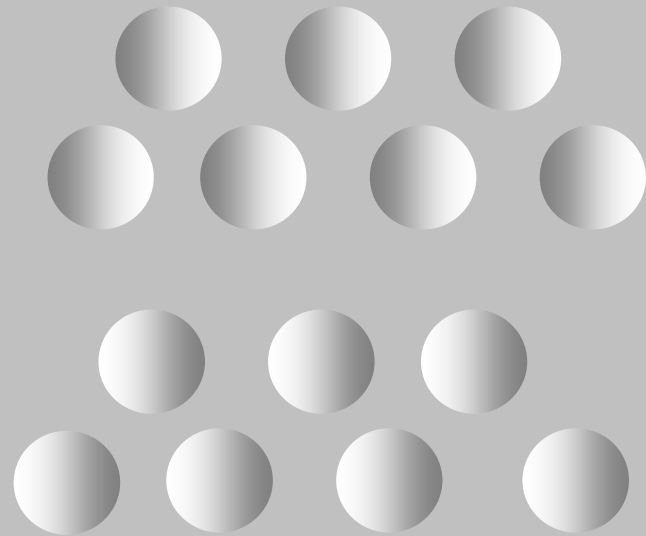

Several important and fascinating topics are presented using PowerPoint slides, handouts and professionally prepared Video or DVD productions. Although dealing with complex issues the lectures will be designed to be understandable and enjoyable to the interested senior high school student and adults.
